



Homeowner and DIY non-friable asbestos removal **Course Outline**

Application of the Course

Course content is specifically designed for the home owner to remove bonded (non-friable) asbestos products in accordance with relevant Queensland Legislation.

Delivery

Course content is delivered in 4 sections with assessment questions at the conclusion of each section. Course material can be delivered online or face to face.

The course is delivered by Keys Human Resources Pty Ltd, RTO: 3191. The Queensland Department of Health has approved this course for the certification of persons for the removal of asbestos in accordance with clause 2E of Part 1A of the *Public Health Regulation 2005*. Online courses need to be completed in a maximum of 30 days from the date of enrolment

Limitations

The successful completion of this course entitles the learner to remove bonded (non-friable) asbestos products only. The removal of un-bonded (friable) asbestos products is not covered within the course and can only be attempted by licensed professionals.

The removal of bonded (non-friable) asbestos containing materials can only be attempted the person who has successfully completed this course.

The successful completion of this course can't be used as a certification to participate in commercial bonded (non-friable) asbestos removal activities.

Certification

Successful participants will be issued with a certificate in Home Owners Course for the Removal of Bonded (non-friable) asbestos. This certificate will remain current for a period of 2 years from the date of issue.

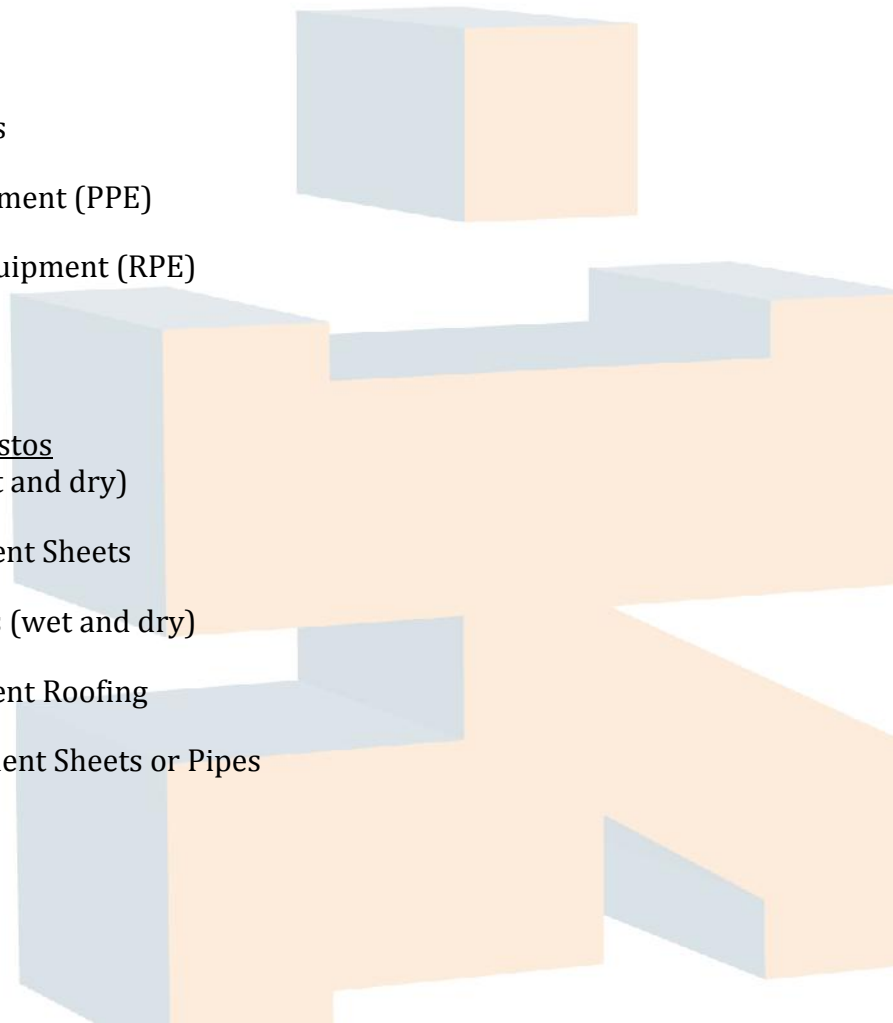
